Travelling by Underground

From Waterloo Underground Station (7 min walk)

Tube Lines: Bakerloo | Jubilee | Northern | Waterloo & City

- Follow South Bank exit signs
- At street level turn right onto York Road A3200 follow London Eye and St Thomas' Hospital signage
- The London Eye and County Hall will be seen on the right along this road
- Continue straight, past, to Westminster Bridge Road
- Turn left and cross the traffic junction to DLD College London
- The entrance foyer is on the right side of the building

From Westminster Underground Station (7 min walk)

Tube Lines: Circle | District | Jubilee

- Follow Exit 1 Westminster Bridge/Westminster Pier signs
- Walk over the River Thames across Westminster Bridge
- Once past St Thomas' Hospital on the right and the Park Plaza Westminster Bridge London hotel on the left, cross the traffic junction to DLD College London
- The entrance foyer is on the right side of the building



From Lambeth North Underground Station (6 min walk)

Tube Line: Bakerloo

- Exit onto Westminster Bridge Road
- Turn right and walk up the road towards the railway bridge
- At the Co-op cross the road and continue under the railway bridge
- At the traffic lights, turn left and the entrance to DLD College London is at the right side of the building

Travelling by Train

From Waterloo National Rail Station (8 min walk)

- Follow Exit 5 or Step free access from Exit 3
- Left out of the station and then turn left onto York Road A3200
- Cross this road at one of the traffic lights
- The London Eye and County Hall will be seen on the right along this road
- Continue straight, past the Park Plaza Westminster Bridge London hotel on the left, to Westminster Bridge Road
- Turn left and cross the traffic junction to DLD College London
- The entrance foyer is on the right side of the building

From Waterloo East National Rail Station (12 min walk)

• Cross the footbridge to Waterloo station and follow directions from Waterloo National Rail Station above

Travelling by Bus

- The closest bus stops to the college are:
 - County Hall/St Thomas' Hospital on Westminster Bridge Road
 - Lower Marsh on Westminster Bridge Road
 - St Thomas' Hospital on Lambeth Palace Road
 - o County Hall on York Road
 - Waterloo Station bus terminal.

Travelling by Car

<u>Parking</u>

The closest car park is located behind DLD College London on Upper Marsh. Please note that this is a one way street and access is via Lambeth Palace Road.

Britannia Parking, London Waterloo, Upper Marsh, London SE1 7EL

Walk back to Lambeth Palace Road and turn right to the college – just a 2 minute walk.

Arriving by Taxi

DLD College London sits on a Red Route and traffic is not permitted to stop. Please request a drop off or collection from Upper Marsh opposite Britannia Parking (SE1 7EL). Walk back to Lambeth Palace Road and turn right to the college – just a 2 minute walk.

Arriving by Plane

- Heathrow International Airport is to the West of London
 - By train the Heathrow Express takes 15 minutes to London Paddington. From there take the underground
 - By underground take the Bakerloo line to Waterloo (direction Elephant & Castle) (15mins) or Circle line (via Victoria) to Westminster (20mins)
 - > By car approximately an hour's drive, traffic dependent
- London City Airport is our closest airport in the East of London
 - By DLR & tube take the DLR to Canning Town (direction Stratford International) and change to the Jubilee line (direction Stanmore) for Waterloo
 - > By car approximately 40 min drive, traffic dependent
- Luton Airport is North of London
 - By train take the bus shuttle from the airport to Luton Airport Parkway train station. Then join the Thameslink train service to London Bridge and change train to London Waterloo East (direction Charing Cross). Cross the footbridge to Waterloo station and follow directions from Waterloo National Rail Station in travelling by train section above
- Gatwick Airport is South of London
 - By train there are several options:
 - 1. Gatwick Express an express service to London Victoria (30 min) (NB currently suspended). Swap to Circle/District line to Westminster (direction Eastbound)
 - 2. Southern Train to London Victoria then take underground as above
 - 3. Thameslink Train (direction London Bridge) to London Waterloo (change at Clapham Junction)
 - 4. Thameslink Train to London Bridge and change train to London Waterloo East (direction Charing Cross). Cross the footbridge to Waterloo station and follow directions from Waterloo National Rail Station in travelling by train section above
 - By car approximately 90 min drive, traffic dependent
