## YOUR FIRST DAY

We ask new students to arrive at school for enrolment in advance of the start of term. You will meet your Housemaster or Housemistress who will fill you in on what to expect when term starts.

New day students (Sixth Form, IFP) - Wednesday 31 August 2022, 9.00am

New day students (GCSE, APC)- Wednesday 31 August 2022, 2.00pm

**We will let you know what to bring with you nearer the time.**

**Term starts on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 at 8.30am**

Once term starts there will be an induction period. During this time, you will meet your tutor who will help you keep an overview on your academic progress.

## GETTING TO SCHOOL

From Waterloo Station (5 mins): There are many exits from the station – follow signs for the South Bank. The simplest route is along York Road. Leave the mainline station from exit 5 down the main steps. Turn left and immediately left again onto York Road. Continue, and you will pass the London Eye and County Hall on your right. When you reach Westminster Bridge Road, cross to St Thomas' Hospital, and follow the pavement to the left, away from the bridge. You will see DLD College London – it is the curved white building opposite the hospital on Westminster Bridge Road.

From Westminster Underground Station (10 mins): Leave the station and cross Westminster Bridge on its right side (this is the pavement that runs alongside the Big Ben clock tower and Parliament). Once over the Thames, you will pass St. Thomas' Hospital on your right. Continue, and you will see DLD College – it is the curved white building opposite the hospital on Westminster Bridge Road.







## STUDYING IN LONDON

DLD College London is in the heart of London, at the foot of Westminster Bridge overlooking the Houses of Parliament. You have everything you could possibly wish for on your doorstep with museums, galleries, restaurants, palaces and parks to keep you entertained outside of your study.

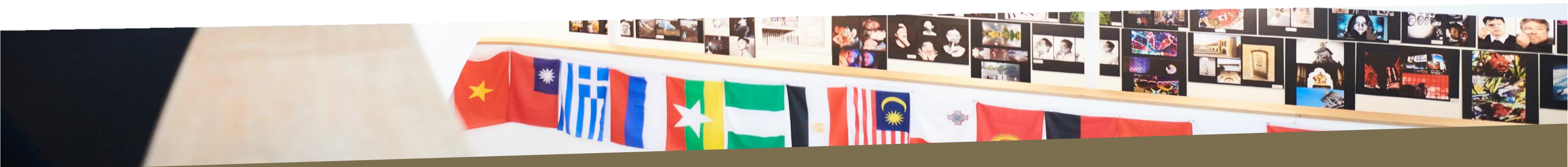
Getting around London is easy. As well as buses, Waterloo Station is just next door so you have convenient access to the overground and underground train networks or, if you want to walk, there are some beautiful places to explore close by.

## BEING PART OF OUR COMMUNITY

As a day student you are very much part of the DLD College London community. You will still be able to take advantage of the trips and activities that we arrange at the weekends. These range from visits to the theater and museums to attendance at major sporting events. We also have day trips to other cities of interest or to the coast in the summer.

If you wish to stay after school to work with other students, you need to speak to one of the Houseparents (sitting at the desk by the lifts). You also need to sign in as a visitor of a boarder who will be responsible for you out of school hours. The Global Kitchen is open to day students for breakfast and dinner which costs between £2.50 -3.50, depending on what you choose.

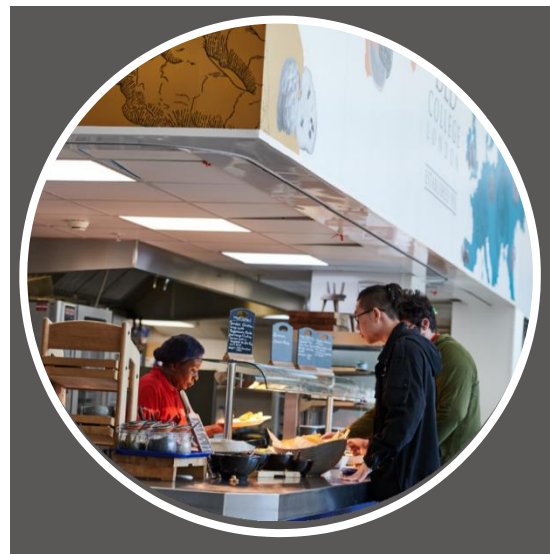




## FOOD

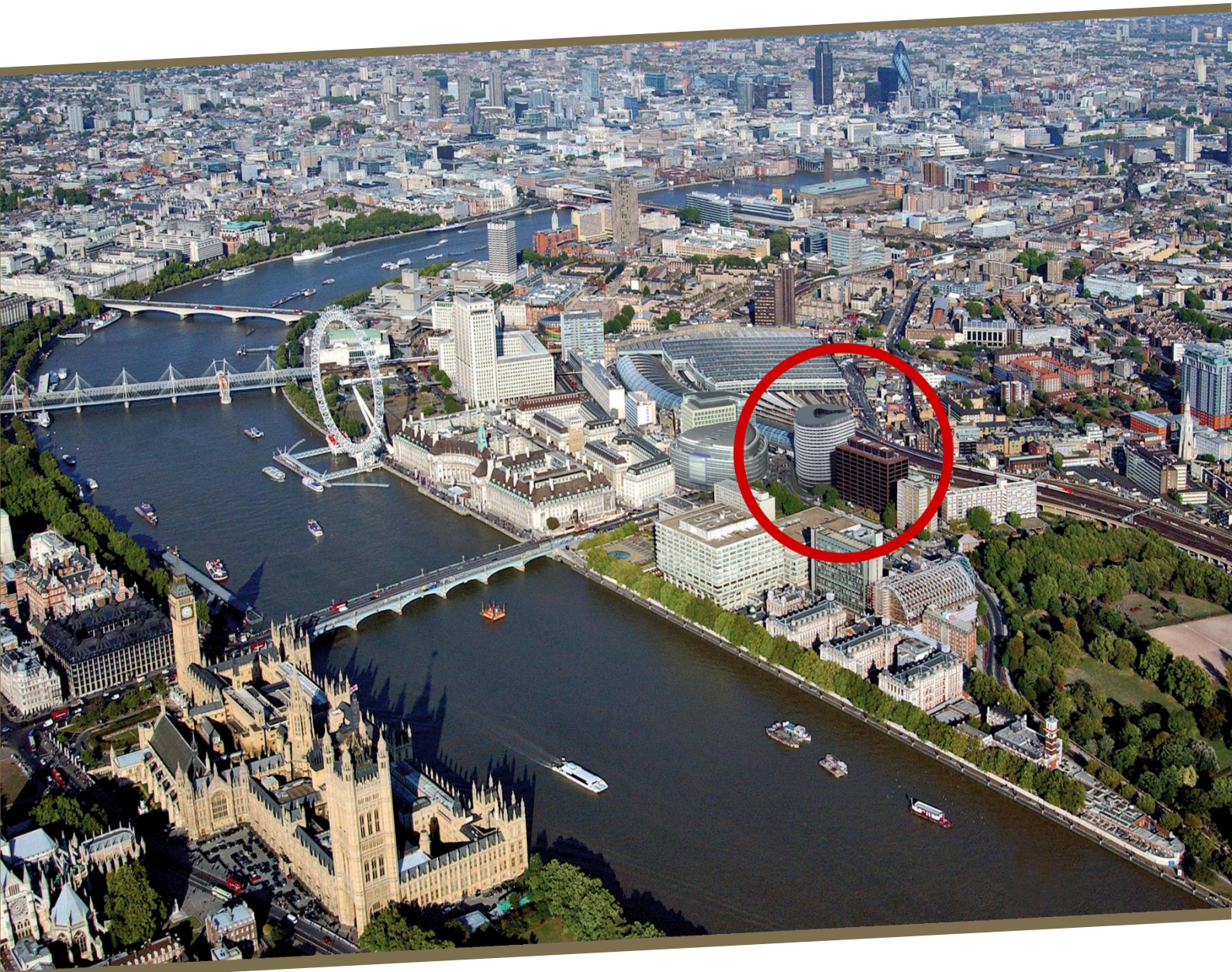
Email
